Our District



Skyway Water & Sewer District provides water and sewer service to approximately 3,400 water connections (over 10,000 population) and 4,100 sewer connections. SWSD runs on a 2024 operating budget of \$2.8million and a 2024 capital budget of \$10.6 million. There are two departments with a total of 11 FTEs, including 6 FTEs in the operations department. The water service area covers approximately 1.8 square miles and the sewer service area cover approximately 2.7 square miles, situated in unincorporated King County.

The water system includes a combined 2.2-million-gallon storage capacity from 5 reservoirs, 3 pump stations, 8 pressure zones, a 325-GPM treatment facility, and approximately 40 miles of water main. The District purchases drinking water from Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) as a member of Cascade Water Alliance and from the City of Renton and operates its own year-round wells and treatment facility.

The sewer system includes approximately 47 miles of sewer main, with 9 lift stations over 13 sewer basins. The District collects and conveys wastewater to the King County Regional System's West Point Plant in the City of Seattle and South Plant in the City of Renton for treatment.



Located in King County, Washington, Skyway Water & Sewer District (SWSD) is headquartered in the unincorporated area south of Seattle, bordered by the neighboring cities of Seattle. Renton and Tukwila and the shores of Lake Washington, Just 10 miles from downtown Seattle and 2 miles from downtown Renton and Tukwila, the Skyway/West Hill community is a hidden gem, with stunning views of Mount Rainier. Lake Washington, and the Cascade and Olympic Mountains.
